Bus Facilities:- Bus Facilities are available in our school.



Smart Classes :- All the necessary classes are well equipped with Smart class. It will save the teachers time and teacher can express their views effectively, through smart class.



Attendance and punctuality:- It is very important that students should attend the school regularly and arrive on time. If for any reason, students are unable to attend school, we must have a phone call to school office on every day of absence followed by a letter on their return to school.

Medical care :- If a child becomes ill or injured in any way he/she is taken to the first aid officer in the Medical Room. It is likely that the problem can be dealt with in school, but if not, the parents will be contacted and if necessary, arrangement will be made for the child to receive medical help, including treatment at hospital.



School Conduct:-

1. The School, diary must be brought to school daily.
2. Student should be habitually clean and neatly dressed. Appropriate school uniform must be worn to school everyday and for all school functions.
3. The entire students must be punctual in every thing required of them to do, beginning with coming to school on time .
4. The students must always carry and display their I-cards in the transport vehicle and the school premises.
5. No student should remain in the classroom during assembly time.
6. No student should leave the classroom without permission of a teacher.
7. Use of abusive language, physical assault and any kind of misbehaviour with other schoolmates will carry for disciplinary action.
8. Students are required to give due respect and regards to all teachers and employees of the school.
9. Students must throw all the rubbish in the dust bins and not anywhere students must exhibit at all times good manner taught in school .

Co Operation from parents :

1. Do check your child school Dairy daly.
2. Please see that your child carries books and notebooks according to the time table. All books are not required every day.
3. Encourage your child to take balanced interest in studies, in sports and co-curricular activities
4. Before the child leaves for school do check if he/she is wearing full and proper uniform.
5. Communicate with us through diary or in person regarding any problem concerning your child.
6. Leave application must be sent to the class teacher without delay, if your child is absent.

School Discipline

Discipline is the law of nature. Without it, nothing works. Inculcating discipline amongst children is the most significant aspect of education and is not confined to school alone. Parents, too, must co-operate with the school in observing these norms:

1. Attendance is compulsory for celebration of National Days.
2. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence from school, habitual late coming, leaving the school premises without permission, disobedience and any type of unruly and objectionable behavior are considered to be grave acts of indiscipline on the part of a student which can lead to his/her expulsion from the school.
3. The school uniform, only in prescribed school colour, should be immaculate, clean and smart, and should be worn on all working days and functions. Actions will be taken against students who are habitually improperly dressed.
4. Students on their way to and from the school are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner. Being on the road in any mode of transport entails caution, care and attention to safety rules. personal reasons must inform their parents/ guardians in advance.
6. Students are expected to take proper care of the school property. It is for their convenience. They should not break any item of furniture and fixtures within the school.
7. They should not write, scratch or engrave graffition desks, chairs and other surfaces.
8. They should not damage or remove things belonging to other students.
9. Damage done even by accident must be reported at once to the Principal/ Headmistress/Class Teacher. Anyone who notices something damaged must report the matter to any of the personnel mentioned above.
10. If a student causing damage to the school property is identified, he/she will be charged with a fine.
11. In the event of collective damage to school property in a classroom, the entire class occupying that classroom will have to bear the cost of damages.

12. The school is not to be held responsible for the loss of personal belongings. It is not advisable for students to bring valuables to the school.

13. Parents are requested not to give more than Rs. 100/-to their ward. If for some reason, he has to bring more, written information must be sent to the class teacher.

Leave Rules for Students

1. No Half Day Leave is permitted. In case of any family function or other programme, parents are requested not to send the child to the school.
2. Children are expected to attend school regularly. Under affiliation Bye-Laws of the Central Board of Secondary Education, all
5. Students who expect to reach home late after the school due to students are expected to log in a minimum attendance of 75% of the total working days in the academic session. As such, no leave of absence is granted unless parents/guardians submit an application well in advance on plausible grounds for absence.
3. In case of sickness for any period of time, a Medical Certificate must be attached with the leave application.
4. If the unauthorized absence exceeds a period of 15 days, the name of the absent student is struck off the rolls of the school. A penalty of Rs.5,00/- shall be charged in case the re-joining is granted.
5. Student suffering from infectious diseases such as Chicken Pox, Cholera, Measles, Mumps, Whooping-Cough, Swine Flu and Jaundice must observe the prescribed period of Quarantine, and on returning to school, should produce a fitness certificate permitting him/her to do so.

School Library Rules

1. Each member / student will be provided a non-transferable borrower's ticket at the beginning of the new session which is to be produced before the librarian to get books issued from the library.
2. The readers shall not sub-lend the books issued by the library.
3. Borrowers must satisfy themselves about the physical condition of the books before borrowing or else they shall be held responsible for any damage or mutilation noticed at the time of returning.
4. If the book is lost, the reader has to pay the cost of the book or replace the book.
5. The students must return the book on the given due date.
6. Late fine will be charged Rs. 2.00 per day per volume after the due date.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

1. Attendance in school is compulsory. Absence from must be supported by a medical certificate. Excuse from school may be granted on compassionate grounds and on a case-by-case basis. All medical certificates or letters of excuse must be submitted to the form Teacher immediately when the student returns to school. Absence without valid reason will be deemed as truancy.
2. Parents need to apply for leave of absence for their child from the Vice-Principal to leave or absent themselves from school for urgent private matters. Permission to leave school early may be granted for special class. The form Teacher must be informed by the student and permission must be obtained from the principal or Vice-principal. His/Her parent/guardian will be contacted and his/her name will be entered in the Early Dismissal book in the General Office. Students may leave for overseas travel only during school - announced official holidays.
3. Students must be punctual for school all School events. Students who are late for school i.e. after morning assembly are subjected to late-coming procedures which include a report slip before they are allowed back to class.
